The complex encompasses basic amenities viz., lodging & boarding, network services, road transport, railways, flight, hospital, etc. It is an excellent venue for holding big conferences and retreats. It features modern means of communication, transport, extensive kitchen and dining facilities and a Conference Hall with a seating capacity of 1,600 with simultaneous translation facilities in six languages. For big programmes there is a spectacular Diamond Hall with a seating capacity of 20,000.
